# THEOLOGY THURSDAY - ST. LEO UNIVERSITY

In March, we took Dorothy Day Tampa on the road. Four Dorothy Day Tampa leaders joined 35 students on the rural Dade City, FL campus for 5 PM Mass, followed by dinner and discussion – *Who is Servant of God, Dorothy Day?* 

What did we hope to achieve with our presentation to St. Leo U students and faculty? Introduce Dorothy Day - someone they could relate to and identify with.

- A hot mess who not only read but lived the classics.
- Put her life together through surrender.
- Responded to a higher calling, something greater than herself.
- Had a spiritual hunger, not initially satisfied but was eventually.
- Achieved a sense of security that many of the students lack.
- Provided a transcendent framework for their faith.
